# Where to Park in Old Town

For events and concerts sponsored by  
the Department of Recreation, Parks and Cultural Activities

Please be aware of parking regulations and fines for violations. Visitor parking in some residential areas and meter parking are limited. Meter feeding is prohibited. Please read the signs before you park. Parking limits are strictly enforced.

In addition to regular parking garages and metered parking, parking is available at Simpson Properties Garages, 700 North Fairfax Street and American Real Estate Partners, 44 Canal Plaza, special \$5 fee.



Visitors to the historic district are encouraged bike, walk or take the Metrorail Yellow or Blue lines to the King Street Station and take the free King Street Trolley, or DASH or Metro buses to the event.
