Music in Montgomery Park Series Continues at Dogtoberfest!

Old Town North Community Partnership in Alexandria hosts local performers, pets, and family fun

Alexandria, VA - October 23, 2025 - The next Music in Montgomery Park concert in Old Town North's Montgomery Park is scheduled for this Sunday, October 26th from 12:00-1:00 pm, as part of the annual Dogtoberfest celebration (rain date: Sunday, November 2nd). The concert - featuring local performer Mike Seti - and Dogtoberfest are hosted by the Old Town North Community Partnership.

The Music in Montgomery Park Series is a free, pet- and family-friendly event and part of the Old Town North Annual Event Season sponsored by HRP Group, which is currently redeveloping the former power plant site in Old Town North. Music programming is made possible by the generous support of Burke and Herbert Bank. Following a winter hiatus, the series will return in spring 2026 with concerts in April, May, and June.
